**Partnering to Assist our AME Brothers and Sisters** – This week, Pastor Debra received this letter sent to churches asking for assistance to help the AME Congregation in SLC restore part of their building. Below are some ways you can help.

Dear Friend and Esteemed Colleague,

Historic Trinity African Methodist Episcopal Church was organized as Utah's first African-American congregation (before Utah became a state). Historic Trinity was placed on the state and National Register, July 30, 1976.

Historic Trinity is making long-overdue updates to our downstairs Bourdeaux Fellowship Hall. Restoration of this space is vital to our church ministry. Plans include a kitchen, restrooms, office, general room, and meeting space. It will allow us to safely assemble (socialize), do more community outreach, and grow our congregation. We need your assistance in the weighty undertaking of making our fellowship hall dreams reality.

You can be a key partner in raising the funds needed to complete the restoration of our church. A simple donation of \$25 or more will help us tremendously in reaching our goal. In order to complete the restoration, it will cost the church \$150,000.00. Trinity Church has raised \$87,000.00. The church goal is to raise \$63,000 to bring everything to completion.
